

DDES "Park and Walk" & Student Drop-Off

We encourage families to bike, take public transit, or carpool to school. If you need to drive, there are over 500 meters and over 250 free parking spaces within a 5-minute walk of the DDES building.

Please give yourself enough time to find a spot (parking can be competitive downtown), and enjoy walking to the building with your child. The city is part of their "classroom"!

A FEW CAUTIONS: If you need to drop off or pick up in front of the building, please pull over

in the green areas indicated above.

Do not park in the "DPS employee only" area

in the alley north of 19th Ave, or block the entrance to the parking garage beneath the DDES building on Lincoln.

If you need to leave your car for *any* length of time, please park at a meter or other designated parking space. DPS Security and the City of Denver will ticket cars parked an expired meter or left unattended in the loading zone.
